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## **Crochet Radiant® Scarf**

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To work with Radiant, only crochet with

the thread above the

evelets.

### **Supplies:**

- Loops & Threads Radiant® (3.5 oz / 100 g; 26.4 yds / 24 m) #4 Sapphire – 1 ball
- Crochet Hook: US-7 (4.5 mm) Or size needed to obtain gauge.
- Notions: Large-eye yarn needle

**Finished Measurements:** 



Beginner / Débutante / Novicecia

Instructions:

Working along eyelet edge of yarn, insert hook under first eyelet and pick up a loop. Chain 6 stitches, working into every other eyelet, turn.

**Row 1:** Single crochet into 2nd chain from hook, single crochet into next 4 chains and turn.

**Row 2:** Chain 1, single crochet in each single crochet across. Repeat row 2 until a small amount of Radiant remains and fasten off last stitch.

Gauge is not important for this project.

32 in (81 cm) long x 4.5 in (11.5 cm) wide.

### **Stitches Used:**

5 sts = 4.5 in (11.5 cm)

Chain stitch

Gauge:

Single Crochet

## **Special terms/Techniques to be taught:**

- Radiant<sup>®</sup> is a net yarn that consists of a netted piece topped by a row of "eyelets". To work with Radiant®, only crochet with the thread above the eyelets. The net area under the eyelets will form soft ruffles when crocheted.
- To crochet: Insert hook into each eyelet and pull only top thread through stitch – do not try to pull complete strand of yarn through. Finished piece will be ruffled on both sides.

### Finishing:

Weave in ends. If you have difficulty weaving in ends, you may secure them by sewing them down with a sewing needle and matching sewing thread.

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
