

# My First Headband

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## Supplies:

- Mary Maxim Ultra Mellowspun, 80 yds, Cotton colorway.
- 4 mm Crochet Hook
- Darning needle
- Scissors

## Abbreviations:

- blo - Back loop only
- Ch - Chain
- Sc - Single Crochet
- Slst - Slip Stitch
- Sts - Stitches

## Gauge & Sizing:

9 sts x 12 rows = 2"

## Pattern Notes:

This pattern is worked in rows until the desired length is achieved. You will work each stitch in the back loop only to get the ribbing effect.

## Instructions

Create a slip knot and make 19 chains.

**Row 1:** Sc in the second chain from hook and in each remaining chain. (18 sts)

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (counts as sc) and turn your work. Make one Sc in each stitch. (18 sts)

Repeat row 2 until your headband measures 18" long (or until it stretches comfortably around your head).

**Assembly:** Fold in half and Slst in the blo of each stitch of both sides to secure. Bind off and weave in your ends. Take a 4 ft length of yarn and wrap around to pinch the front. Tie ends in a secure knot and hide beneath wrapped yarn.
