## Lion Brand® Shawl in a Ball

### Misty Haze Cowl

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 69 in. (175.5 cm)

**Finished Height** About 18 in. (45.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- 828-201 Lion Brand Shawl in a Ball: Restful Rainbow  
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10.5 [6.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Shawl in a Ball (Article #828). 58% cotton, 39% acrylic, 3% other; package size: 5.30oz/150.00 gr. (481yds/440m) pull skeins*



#### **GAUGE:**

12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (knit on RS, purl on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### **NOTES:**

1. Cowl is worked in one piece on large needles.
2. Ends of piece are sewn together to make the Cowl.



### **COWL**

Cast on 54 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** Slip the first st, knit to end of row.

**Row 2:** Slip the first st, work in St st (knit on RS, purl on WS) to end of row.

Repeat Row 2 until about 2 yds.

(2 m) of yarn remains.

Bind off.

### **FINISHING**

Sew ends of piece together to make Cowl.

Weave in ends.
