

## POM-POM CROCODILE

### MATERIALS:

- Clover Pom-Pom Maker-Jumbo (Art. No 3128)
- Clover Pom-Pom Maker-Large (Art. No 3126)
- Clover Pom-Pom Maker-Small (Art. No 3124)
- Ultimate Bordeaux Shears 200 (Art. No 4942)
- Yarn
  - Caron Simply Soft-Limelight (2 skeins), Mango (1 skein), Blue Mint(1 skein)
- Felt Sheets (White and Black)
- Glue
- Wooden dowel (12" long)
- Foam Board
- Wooden Circular Board (12" diameter)

### INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: Make all your Pom-Poms following package instructions.

Limelight (Green): 3 Jumbo

6 Large (Note: Package includes two sizes. Make 3 with blue pom-pom maker and 3 with the green pom-pom maker)

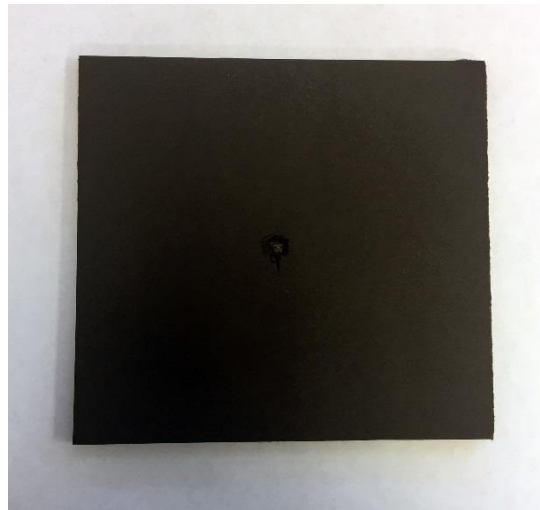
4 Small (Note: Package includes two sizes. Only use yellow pom-pom maker)

(Orange): 4 Small (use yellow pom-pom maker)

Blue Mint: 4 Small (Use yellow pom-pom maker)

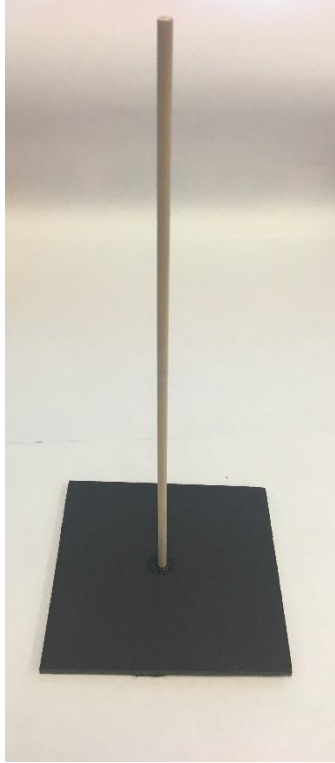
Step 2: Cut squares out of foam board. Sizes 5", 3" 1.5" and 1"

Step 3: Make holes in the center of each foam square. Clover used scissors to pierce hole, but feel free to use any tool that works best.



Step 4: Glue dowel to center of the 5" foam square. Hold dowel in place until dry.

This will provide the stability necessary to maintain structure of project. Clover used hot glue for this because of the quick dry and firm hold. Any glue will work.



Step 5: Once the glue is dry and dowel is in place, tie 3 jumbo pom-poms to the dowel on top of the square base. Add glue to base (between foam board and pom-poms) for extra stability.



Step 6: Place the 3" square through the dowel on top of the 3 jumbo pom-poms. Glue in place directly above jumbo pom-poms. This will provide base for the next layer of pom-poms.



Step 7: Repeat procedure used in Step 5, this time using the 3 pom-poms made using the blue pom-pom maker and be sure to align pom-poms with the layer directly below.

Step 8: Repeat steps 6&7, this time using the 1.5” foam square and 3 pom-poms made with the green pom-pom maker.

Step 9: Repeat steps 6&7, this time using the 1” foam square and 3 of the green pom-poms made with the yellow pom-pom maker.

Step 10: A piece of the wooden dowel will stick out of the top of the green pom-pom pyramid that has been formed. Simply cut the excess dowel.

Step 11: Tie the 4<sup>th</sup> green pom-pom made using the yellow pom-pom maker to the top of the pyramid to give it that point.

Step 12: Cut out 8 white felt triangles, 2 white semi-circles, 2 black semi-circles (about half the size of the white semi-circles) and two small rectangles.

Step 13: Glue 4 triangles on each side of the crocodiles face (as teeth), glue black semi-circles inside of the white semi-circles and then glue those on the jumbo pom-poms aligned with the bottom to make eyes. Glue the small squares on the point of the crocodiles face to make nostrils.

Step 14: Glue the crocodile onto the center of the wooden circular board.

Step 15: Glue 4 Blue Mint pom-poms and 4 Mango pom-poms around the edge of the circular board. Alternating color with a spacing of approx. 4”
