FESTIVE POM POM TASSEL NECK SCARF

MATERIALS:

- Finger Weight Yarn (approx. 400 yards)
- Clover Amour Crochet Hook 4.50 mm (7) (Art. No 1046/7)
- Clover Pom Pom Maker-Extra Small (Art. No 3128)
- Clover Bordeaux Ultimate Scissors 130 (Art. No 4940)
- Clover Tassel Maker (Art. No 9941)
- Clover Handy Thread Twister (Art. No 9942)

ABBREVIATIONS:

Ch: Chain

Dc: Double CrochetSt(s): Stitch(es)Sl st: Slip stitch

GAUGE:

18 dc's and 10 rows=4" in dc

NOTE:

Starting at tip of triangle, make 2 dc in first and last st of each row

PATTERN:

Foundation Row: With crochet hook, ch 5, dc in second ch from hook and next 2 chains (3 dc)

Row 1: ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), dc in same st, dc in next st, 2 dc in last st (5 dc)

Row 2: ch 3, dc in first st, dc in next sts, 2 dc in last st (7 dc)

Row 3: ch 3, dc in first st, dc in back loop of each dc, ending with 2 dc in last st.

Row 4: ch 3, dc in first st, dc in front loop of each dc, ending with 2 dc in last st

Repeat rows 2-4 until you have 53 dc or desired size

At end of next row chain 60 sts, (to make first tie) turn and sc back on chain and return to established pattern, then chain 60 sts for second tie

Sc back on ch and dc across all sts and in scs of first tie, ch 3 and dc across to end of second tie.

Ch 3, dc to end of tie and sl st to first dc of scarf

FINISHING:

Weave in ends and block as desired

With extra small pom pom maker make 6-7 pom poms of various sizes and colors. Tie pom poms on to scarf and leave ends woven through sts. Add loops of yarn scattered as desired.

Make four tassels different colors and loop through ends of ties.
