FLOWER PIN

Intermediate project, which can be completed in 4 hours or less

Supplies Needed

- Punch needle fabric
- Black wool felt Dimensions® 73345
- Gray chenille sock yarn with shimmer accents
- Black sock yarn
- Pin back
- Boye® Punch Needle Set 7495A
- Embroidery hoop
- Sewing needle
- Black glass beads
- Black thread
- Glue

Instructions

- 1. Transfer the pattern to the punch needle fabric, then mount the fabric in the hoop.
- 2. Following the instructions included with the punch needle set, punch the center of the flower with the black sock yarn using the 2.2mm punch needle.
- 3. Punch the petals with the gray chenille sock yarn using the 2.2mm punch needle.
- 4. Sew the beads around the flower center.
- 5. Cut out the flower, leaving a ½" border of blank fabric. Fold and glue the blank fabric to the wrong side.
- 6. Glue the flower to the felt. Trim the felt to create a 1/4" border.
- 7. Tuck and glue black yarn around the edge of the flower to hide the fabric.
- 8. Glue the pin back to the back of the flower.
